**Re: Redevelopment of existing port facilities at Ringaskiddy, Co. Cork
Notice of Significant Additional Information in Relation to a Direct Planning
Application to An Bord Pleanála, Reference Number PL 04.PA0035**

Dear Sir / Madam,

Port of Cork Company, Custom House, Custom House Road, Cork, made an application for permission to An Bord Pleanála on 1st May 2014 for a 10-year permission for the redevelopment of existing port facilities consisting of:

- Container Berths and Multi-purpose Berth
- Deepwater Berth Extension
- Road Improvements
- Construction of a new Public Pier, Slipway and Boarding Platform

all located at Ringaskiddy, County Cork and as fully described in the original public notice for the application. A full copy of the application and accompanying environmental impact statement and Natural impact statement was circulated to your office for information at the time of the application.

Please be advised that Port of Cork Company has submitted significant additional information in relation to a direct planning application to An Bord Pleanála, reference number PL 04.PA0035. Significant additional information in the form of a revision to the environmental impact statement and a revised screening for appropriate assessment, was lodged with An Bord Pleanála ('the Board') on 11th February 2015. I attach a copy of the significant additional information lodged with the Board for your information.

Submissions or observations in relation to the significant additional information may be made only to An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, during a period of four weeks, commencing on 18th February 2015, relating to:

- (i) The implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development in the area concerned,
- (ii) The likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and
- (iii) The likely significant effects, or adverse effects on the integrity of a European site of the proposed development,

if carried out.

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In accordance with Article 217 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2006, such submissions / observations must also include the following information:

- (i) The name of the person making the submission or observation, the name of the person acting on his or her behalf, if any, and the address to which any correspondence relating to the application should be sent,
- (ii) The subject matter of the submission or observation, and
- (iii) The reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based in full.

Any submission or observations which do not comply with the above requirements cannot be considered by the Board. Any enquires in relation to the application process should be directed to the Strategic Infrastructure Development Section of An Bord Pleanála (Tel. 01 8588100). A person may question the validity of any such decision by the Board by way of an application for judicial review under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986), in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended.

Any submissions or observations must be received by the Board **not later than 5.30pm on 19th March 2015**. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you require further copies of the significant additional information submitted.
